Amplifier designed jointly by guitarist John Parsons and Pablo Kahayan. British sound based on the 70's, but with the ability to deliver more modern sounds.

The JPK-50 Head increases both your instrument's timbre and dynamic range while maintaining the characteristic sound of each guitar model while increasing its nuances.

This amplifier has a very natural sustain that lets the musical passages run in a more comfortable without sacrificing natural sound.

SPECS:

- Power 50W.
- Two channels with separate volume control. Bright Channel 1, Channel 2 Low, the configuration of 4 Jacks.
- Valves: 2 x EL34, 3 12AX7, selected as electrical by dynamic and timbral characteristics.

CONTROLS

Cream Mode:

Vintage (Class A) and Modern (Class A/B). · Vintage: more creamy, compress sound, ideal by

chords with grainy texture. · Modern: tight sound extra punch and hard. Ideal for lead guitar.

Dynamic Response: Hard, Medium, Soft. Work with the dynamic team, providing smooth and compressed textures or more open and strident.

Variac control. Spongy, Medium, Bold: It has different timbrical sounds, all within the silky medium range, and can select an enhancement treble or midrange frequencies.
